A Bag of Nothingness

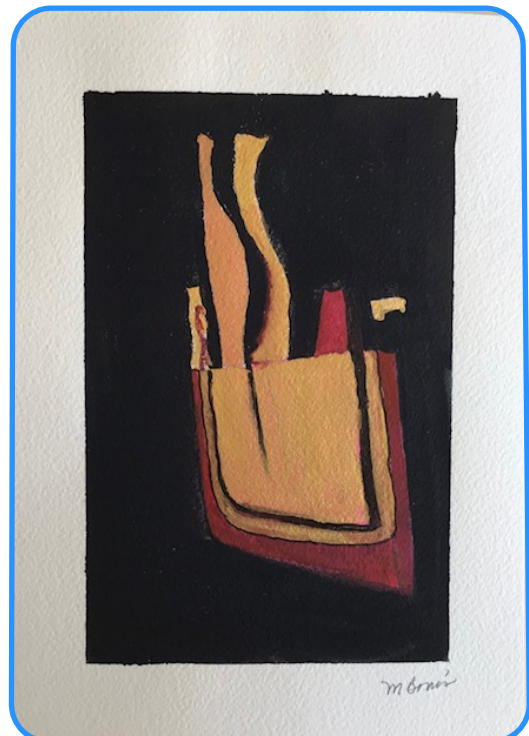
